### What is the difference between the Annual Fund and the Educational Enhancement Fund (EEF)? Why am I asked to give to both?

The Annual Fund is used when education happens in the classroom, not on a field trip. Every student, and faculty member benefits from the Annual Fund. When you support this fund, you are supporting a better education for students now. Our greatest need is for contributions toward these day-to-day operational costs. Please help us today and "Make a Difference" by donating to the Annual Fund.

### The Educational Enhancement Fund (EEF)

is used exclusively to pay for materials and activities that enhance the students' education. The budgeted cost for these enhancements is \$20,000, or approximately \$76 per student. Rather than require students to bring in money each time a field trip occurs or there is a special request from teachers, we use the EEF to fund these events. ### I Pay Tuition. Why Should I Give?

The total cost of educating a student at BACS is approximately \$14,000 per year. No one is asked to pay the full amount. All families receive some financial support through the Annual Fund and endowment income. Our goal is to provide children with an affordable education with a spiritual foundation based on the teachings of the New Church. Because no one is asked to pay the full tuition, we rely on donations to provide this education year-after-year.


# Why is it so important to get 100% participation from parents?
