Teachings of the New Church

Since "fishing" means in the Word the instruction and conversion of people who are in external or natural good [patterns of life], in which good [patterns] were most of the Gentiles at that time, "fish" means the things of the natural person, and "boat" doctrine from the Word; therefore "the right side of the boat" means living good lives. This makes clear the signification of what the Lord said, "Cast the net on the right side of the boat," namely, that they should teach the good ways of living. That they would thus convert the Gentiles to the church means by their finding in such abundance that "they were not able to draw the net for the multitude of fishes."
