Teachings of the New Church

Obedience, and the desire that good has for truth, is described by her giving the prophet water, as she had been commanded to do, and then by her making a cake for him first from the little she had, and for herself and her son after that. Consequent enrichment in the good of truth is meant when it says that the pot of flour was not used up and the flask of oil did not fail. "Water" in the internal sense is truth. "Flour" is truth derived from good. "Oil" is the good of love. "A cake" made from these ingredients is truth joined to its own good.

From all this it is plain that "a widow" means one who has good and a desire for truth. Good and its desire for truth is described by her charity towards the prophet, greater than towards herself and her son, "a prophet" being teachings that present truth, as has been shown above.
