Luke 1:46-55

And Mary said: "My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior. For He has regarded the lowly state of His maidservant; for behold, henceforth all generations will call me blessed. For He who is mighty has done great things for me, and holy is His name. And His mercy is on those who fear Him from generation to generation. He has shown strength with His arm; he has scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts. All true worship consists in adoration of the Lord, adoration of the Lord in humility, and humility in the acknowledgement that in oneself there is nothing living, and nothing good, ... and in the acknowledgment that everything living and everything good is from the Lord. The more someone acknowledges these things, not with the mouth, but with the heart, the more they are in humility; and consequently, the more they are in adoration, that is, in true worship, and the more they are in love and charity, and the more in happiness.

Apocalypse Revealed 54-56

"When I [John] saw [the One like the Son of Man], I fell at His feet as though dead" (Revelation 1:17). This symbolically means that he experienced a failure of his own life owing to such a presence of the Lord. "But He laid His right hand on me." This symbolizes life then infused from the Lord. "Saying to me, 'Do not be afraid." This symbolizes a revival, and from the deepest humility then, adoration. Moreover, because upon his revival a holy fear seized him, the Lord said, "Do not be afraid." A holy fear ... comes over a person when life from the Lord enters in place of one's own life. One's own life is to look to the Lord from oneself, while life from the Lord is to look to the Lord from the Lord, and yet doing so as though of oneself. When a person is seized by this life, he sees that he is nothing, and that only the Lord is anything.

Arcana Coelestia 8179

In prayer inspired by God, there is always the thought and belief that the Lord alone knows whether what is sought would be beneficial or not. Therefore, the one who prays leaves the Lord to decide whether to listen to what he asks for, then accordingly pleads that the Lord's will may be done, not his own.
